Professor Gautam Sen's Research and Teaching interests are in the interdisciplinary areas of Strategic Studies, International Security, International Relations, Peace and Conflict Studies, Business Management Studies and in the broad field of Education to integrate them with Public Policy Making. He continues to teach in all these areas in various Universities and Business Management Schools. Presently he is Member Board of Trustees, Indian Institute of Education(IIE), an Adjunct faculty of Goa University Centre for Latin American Studies, Visiting Professor at the Management Institute of Learning and Excellence, Pune, Chairman, Faculty Committee for Research and Training of the Centre for Education Studies, IIE, Pune and Chief Editor of The Indian Journal of Education and Social Change.

Was Officer Instructor IMA and General Staff Officer at Amy Headquarters, Granted Premature retirement in 1974. Post Graduate studies(1974-79) in Canada and the United States. Sawarkar Chair of Defence and Strategic Studied, University of Pune, UoP(1981-2007), Head, Department of Defence and Strategic Studies, UoP for 20 years, Director Board of College and University Development, UoP, Director National Centre of International Security and Defence Analysis, UoP for 5 years, Director Post Graduate Studies, UoP for 8 years, Member Board of Trustees at the Indian Institute of Education(IIE 2006-2016), and Honorary Director General IIE. Chairman of various UGC Committees, Member of 10th Five year Plan Committee of the UGC, Member of Committees of ICSSR, Department of Electronics etc and many other organizations of the Government of India. UGC Visiting Professor, Gorakhpur University, Visiting Professor, Symbiosis Institute of Telecom Management (2000-2011), Adjunct Professor of Strategic Studies, University of Madras and of Peace Studies at Gujarat Vidyapith.
